POST-TREATMENT CHECKLIST

Please observe the following after treatment with

Kestylane Perlane

• Immediately after the treatment, there may be slight redness, swelling, tenderness and an itching sensation in the treated area. This is a normal result of the injection. The inconvenience is temporary and generally disappears in a day or two. If the inconvenience continues or if other reactions occur, please contact your physician.

• The initial swelling after lip treatment may last longer. Some patients experience swelling for about a week and the lips can look somewhat uneven during this time. This means that the result directly after the treatment should not be seen as the final result.

• Avoid touching the treated area within the following 6 hours. After that, light make-up can be applied and the area can be gently washed with soap and water.

• Until the initial swelling and redness have resolved, do not expose the treated area to intense heat (e.g. solarium and sunbathing) or extreme cold.

• If you have previously suffered from facial cold sores, there is a risk that the needle punctures could contribute to another eruption of cold sores.

• If you are using aspirin or any similar medication, be aware that these may increase the bruising and bleeding at the injection site.

Finally, since Q-MED Esthetics products gradually dissolve, the correction does not last forever. Many people choose to be treated again within a year of the original treatment.
