POST INJECTION INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOTOX (Botulinum Toxin)

- 1. For 4-hours post injection, it is very important to stay in the erect posture. DO NOT sleep, bend your neck/head to read, eat, etc. and DO NOT exercise.
- 2. DO NOT massage, manipulate or touch the area of injection.
- 3. DO NOT take aspirin, aspirin containing products, ibuprofen, Motrin, Aleve, etc. for 7-10 days before injection and for 2 days after injection to help decrease the possibility of bruising. Tylenol is ok to take and is recommended to decrease the chance of headaches.
- 4. For the 4-hour post injection period, DO use the muscles injected as much as possible, for example, frown, smile, and wrinkle your forehead. Muscle activity can improve results.
- 5. Remember that muscle paralysis from Botox takes 3-4 days and may not be complete for 2 weeks. Deep wrinkles will improve but may not resolve completely.
